Introduction

The Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) follows the vision of "Development of a cluster of villages that preserve and nurture the essence of rural community life with focus on equity and inclusiveness without compromising with the facilities perceived to be essentially urban in nature, thus creating a cluster of "Rurban Villages".

For effective planning and development of rural areas, efficient use of rural land and investment for various activities like housing, physical and social infrastructure, transportation, etc. has to be made. This warrants that natural resources particularly rural land is used in an efficient and equitable manner. For the promotion of integrated and inclusive rural development, spatial planning becomes imperative. While for urban areas development controls and other norms and standards have existed for several decades in India, for rural areas development norms and benchmarks are largely non-existent. State governments even do not have organizational appropriate machinery for preparing and implementing integrated development plans in rural areas (Ministry of Rural Development, 2016).

This training has been designed and proposed to introduce and provide knowledge on the basic concepts, tools and technologies for spatial planning and Monitoring of Rurban Clusters for the functionaries of Nagaland, Sikkim & Tripura.

Objectives

- ❖ To introduce basics of Geo-informatics (RS,GIS&GPS)
- ❖ To introduce RADPFI Guidelines 2021 for planning.
- ❖ To develop working skills on the usage of mobile GPS for asset mapping (Geo-tagging).

- ❖ To develop working skills on analyzing the GIS data layers for planning using Spatial Technology.
