BACKGROUND

The training plays a very important role in preparing the new entrants in the government as well as Non-Government organizations for fulfilling their charter of responsibilities and citizen services. The objective of training programme is to develop generic and domain specific competencies in cutting edge of government functionaries and elected representatives for strengthening their capabilities and bring an attitudinal shift, in order to improve the public service delivery mechanism. In the effective training, there must be training module to deliver the desired objective. The training module is one structured sections of a particular course. The content within a training module should be designed and created to support the learner's intake and retention of the information it contains. Grouping training modules together is used to create step-by-step learning. Each module forms one part of an overall topic, enabling learners to gradually progress through a course, module by module to reach their training goals. It is a tactic that makes training delivered through a learning management system more digestible and achievable manner. Keeping in mind of training needs of Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Panchayati Raj and respective state Governments in reference to national training policies and state training policie, there are huge requirement for development of appropriate training modules in this NE states.

For this purpose the Ministry of PR has launched multipronged solution exchange strategies of the training and capacity building intervention under RGSA in reference to

national training and capacity building framework and other intervention from time to time. The capacity building interventions like the foundation and functional training programme, ToT programme on various RD and sectoral programme for PRIs and related functionaries, the programme on Sustainable Development Goals, training programme on PES, Skill development for women and youth in villages/Panchayats, the policy making workshop, writeshop for 15th Finance Commission Grants, the workshop on State Finance Commission, state election commission etc.

However, there is lack of NE specific C&T module for the training of ERs and functionaries. The States located in NE region are not similar to the other parts of the county. So module developed by various institutions are required to customize as per the requirement of the locality. The implementation of the RD & PR programmes are facing number of challenges such as low generation of man days and quality of assets created under MGNREGS, absence of required benefit of SBM, PMAY and various programmes on social security and low level of Own Source Revenue. Now considering all the above challenges faced by the NE states, a national level writeshop is proposed to be conducted which shall lead for drawing workable CB&T Modules on various areas in the perspective of NE States.

OBJECTIVES

The most vital objectives of the writeshop are the delegates/participants shall be able to:

- a. Develop the various modules as per the need of the States as a whole in reference to the local situation and contemporary needs

- b. Find out the national level thematic areas where the participatory involvement of national expertise and state domains are to be involved
- c. Innovate and exchange the state specific successive ideas which can be adopted in other states
- d. Identify emerging areas where the NIRD&PR can contribute in the policy formulation and innovation.
- e. Share the local specific research areas and attempt to draw the solution in the state and national level which leads for better capacity building and training.

MAJOR CONTENTS/THEMES OF THE WRITESHOP

The Followings are the major contents of the national writeshop.

- a. Tools and techniques for the development of various modules.
- b. National and state level thematic areas for modules
- c. Customize, Sharing and fine tuning the exiting modules.
- d. Use of national and state level domains for module development
- e. Directory of innovation and uses of success stories for development of modules
- f. local specific research findings and uses for module preparation.
- g. Identifying emerging areas for policy advocacy for NIRD&PR and Government of India in respect to RD & PR interventions and capacity building solution

EXPECTED OUTCOME

At the end, national writeshop would come out with various training modules keeping in mind of the state's specific needs. In addition to these, the necessity of the national level agencies for the solution exchange programme and research areas shall be taken up with the partnership of state level agencies. The expected training modules shall be published in the banner of NIRDPR, NERC, Guwahati for the benefits of the training agencies.

METHODOLOGY

The national level writeshop shall be conducted through lecture, discuss interface, experience sharing and exercise through online and home work mode. There would be panel discussions on the presentation of draft modules from the respective state SIRDPRs, ETCs and state agencies.
