## **Background:**

The Fifteenth Finance Commission (XV-FC) was constituted by the President on 27<sup>th</sup> November'2017 and was inter-alia, mandated to recommend measures needed to augment the Consolidated Funds of the states to supplement the resources of Panchayats/RLBs and Municipalities during 2020-25. Subsequently, the Commission was mandated to submit two reports, one for the year 2020-21 and final report for the period 2021-22 to 2025-26. The Commission was submitted its first report covering the financial year 2020-21 to the President on 5<sup>th</sup> December 2019. The Union Government on 31<sup>st</sup> Jan'2020 vide explanatory memorandum as to the Action Taken on the recommendations made by the fifteenth Finance Commission in its report for the year 2020-21 inter-alia accepted the recommendations of the XV-FC in the respect of the Local bodies. At present the commission had submitted its full report to the union government.

The XV-FC have recommended total size of Grants for local bodies amounting to Rs 90,000 crore for twenty eight states. Out of this corpus, the Commission have recommended allocation for RLBs amounting of Rs 60,750 crore in 2020-21. The 50% of the recommended grants will be basic grants (united) and remaining 50% as tied grants. In the meantime the comprehensive framework for Block and District development plans for rural areas is released from Ministry of Panchayati Raj for holistic district development plan keeping in mind of XV-FC Grants.

**Need of the Training Programme:** Consequent upon the recommendation of XV-FC and follow of action, the district and State level officials of states are the main stakeholders through whom the policy framework and blue print of the implementation shall be carried out. In the meantime, the GDPD exercises for 2021-22 is completed. Considering the different local bodies in the NE states (excluded areas where Part -IX & IXA does not apply) and direction of the MoPR for roll out of implementation of XV-FC, the training & capacity building intervention is highly required and proposed here to lead the activities under XV-FC for all NE states. Further it is felt that the training for newly launched framework for preparation of Block and District Development Plans for rural areas is required to be imparted for appropriate stakeholders of NE states. On this context NIRDPR,NERC, Guwahati is proposed five days online National level training of trainers programme on" XV-FC Grants with reference to Block & District Development Plans Preparation" during **26-30 July'2021**.

## **Objectives:**

As the ToT programme is completely action oriented intervention, the participants/trainees shall be able to:

- a. Conduct the training programme in the respective states on cascading method
- b. Frame the SMART(Specific-Measurable-Achievable-Relevant-Timely) objectives for various clientele groups
- c. Explain various recommendations of XV-FC Grants for RLBs

- d. Identify the Present status of GPDPs/VDPs of NE states with specific reference to selected NE States(Meghalaya & Nagaland) devising action points and road map for revisiting of present plans
- e. Draw the States Policy Exercises for XV-FC Grants
- f. Utilise the framework for preparation of Block and district development plans for rural areas
- g. Exercise for V&VI Scheduled Areas.
- h. Converge XV-FC Grants with Sectoral Plan for village poverty reduction plan.
- i. Modulate the Data bank for appropriate Mission Antodaya exercises
- j. Mobilize the State Government and appropriate agencies for draw out of blue print for "Global Peace Village".
