Promotion of entrepreneurship in any society is said to be the key to socioeconomic change and development. More so, worldwide there is a growing appreciation and interest on promoting rural entrepreneurship. Both farm and nonfarm sectors across the rural gamut in India hold huge potential to promote entrepreneurship. However, more often than not, these sectors are often viewed only as cushions for self-sustained economies. In India, although the different flagship programmes of the government like the NRLM, ASPIRE, FPO promotion schemes of NABARD, SFAC etc emphasise upon promotion of entrepreneurship among women and youth in the farm and non-farm sectors, many challenges adorn the path to promoting rural entrepreneurship. Only a right set of strategic interventions with right efforts can cut across these challenges.

Enterprise creation is a process wherein along with motivation and confidence building, one also needs to guide and disseminate knowledge on the process, strategy, business plan and the available schemes and policies. Though strategic initiatives vary across different farm and non-farm enterprises, no enterprise can do without a business plan. Preparing a business plan which is viable and feasible needs acumen and knowledge on the different aspects of the enterprise which is proposed to be taken up. But even before, drawing the business plan itself is a methodical exercise which one should have a-priori knowledge about. Focus should be on the different components of the business plan.

It is in the above light that the Training Programme on 'Business Plan Preparation for Promotion of Farm and Non-Farm Sector Enterprises' is proposed for capacity building of the functionaries of the government and nongovernment organisations, institutions and departments who are into promoting rural farm and non-farm sector enterprises.

Objectives

- i. To orient the participants on the concept of business plan preparation for promoting rural farm and non-farm sector enterprises.
- ii. To equip the participants on the process, approaches and strategies of drawing business plans in the farm and non-farm sector

Course Content

The course content would cover the following broad areas:

1. Opportunity identification in farm & non-farm sectors
2. Venture opportunity profile in farm and non-farm sectors
3. Opportunity shaping exercise
4. Understanding Business Model Canvas
5. Introduction to Business Model Canvas Worksheet
6. Field Visit
7. Exercise in business plan preparation in farm and non-farm sectors

Participants' Level

Functionaries from Department of Rural Development, Department of Panchayati Raj and other Line Departments - SRLMs, RuUrban Mission, Department of Handloom & Handicraft, Department of Agriculture, MOVCD, Department of Industries and Commerce and Development Professionals from the non-government sector/ organisations. Institutes/ universities etc.

Methodology

Adult Learning Methodology would be followed in the Programme. The methodology shall include lectures, group discussions, group work, field visit etc. Audio visual aid and other TLMs would be extensively used in the programme to facilitate better understanding on the subject. Besides the Faculties from NIRD-NERC, subject experts from government and non-government organisations would take sessions in the programme.
