## Background:

Considering Rural Development as an important factor for the growth of the Indian economy, a number of programmes/schemes are being implemented by the Central and State Government, for development of rural areas focusing on poverty alleviation, better livelihood opportunities, strengthening of Panchayati Raj, provision of basic amenities and infrastructure facilities, such as MGNREGA, Mission Antodaya, NRLM, PMGSY/CMGSY, PMAY (G), SBM, NSAP, DDU-GKY, SAGY and many others. There is a general observation that the performance of the programmes/schemes has not been up to the mark or as intended. The reasons for this gap may lie in the participation of different stakeholders, space & time and many other factors too. Here, the matter of concern is that on what ground the performance of the programme/schemes should be measured or judged scientifically and also what kind of techniques & tools to be used for evaluating the impact on quality of lives and livelihoods of the people in a given socio-ecological settings. There is observable gap in the available indicators, tools & techniques and what is required for a given socio-ecological settings.

The gap observed regarding the specific indicators, tools and techniques cannot be filled with present sources of literature only but it needs a workshop for iterative discussion of experienced development professionals and academicians to develop indicators for performance measurement and tools & techniques for impact evaluation through scientific, composite approach and in holistic manner in order to achieve the set targets to generate impact on rural areas and which will result in upliftment of the rural people.

Therefore, to achieve the outcomes at an optimum level a workshop on Developing Performance Indicator, Tools and Techniques for Impact Evaluation of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj Programs is proposed.

## Objectives:

- To develop measurable performance indicators, techniques and tools for impact evaluation of RD and PR programs based on iterative discussion of experienced development professionals and academicians.

- To identify possible data source available in the institution and to generate or collect data based on the scientific framework.
- To identify the upcoming challenges to establish this framework and for mainstreaming this as a scientific and holistic one regarding impact evaluation of RD & PR programs.
- Application of mutually formulated, common guideline for impact evaluation of RD & PR development programs.

- Reviewing the existing techniques and tools
- Gap analysis and formulation of framework
- Development of Measurable and Actionable Performance Indicators
- Develop Techniques and Tools for Impact Evaluation
- Standardisation of Indicators, Techniques and Tools
- Testing the applicability and reliability of Indicators, Techniques and Tools (Field visit)

On completion of the workshop the partner institutions will get a draft of newly formulated framework of Performance Indicators and Tools & Techniques for Impact Evaluation of RD & PR Programmes.
