Background

A computer network is a telecommunications network which allows computers to exchange data. In computer networks, networked computing devices exchange data with each other along network links. The best-known computer network is the Internet. A computer network facilitates interpersonal communications allowing users to communicate efficiently via various means like web portals, email, instant messaging, chat rooms, telephone, video telephone calls, and video conferencing. A network allows sharing of web resources, files, data, and other types of information giving authorized users the ability to access information stored on other computers on the network. Network and Web enabled technologies can enhance performance of the government department to a greater degree and can play a pivotal role in disseminating information and services.

One can utilize web applications for online resource management, scheme management, service delivery, e-commerce, education, digital payment, monitoring and evaluation in a fast, effective and transparent means.

The process of online data management for rural development programmes is being implemented throughout the country. Government is in the process of establishing a massive ICT infrastructure, connectivity backbone and delivery centers across the country under Digital India programme. The vast majority of India's population lives in the villages. To access citizen services from rural areas, last mile connectivity along with user-friendly web interfaces are the two most important requirements among others

Under the above scenario, the training programme on **'Applications of Networking and Web Technologies for Management of RD Programmes'** is designed mainly for the functionaries of Rural Development, Panchayati Raj and Line Departments of North Eastern region of India.

The course would provide a platform to discuss and upgrade skills in network and web management as well as various transactions in the networked environment.

Objectives:

The main objectives of this training programme are:

- To develop understanding on basic ICT applications
- To acquaint with the technical aspects of Network Management
- To develop understanding about the process of Web Publishing and Maintenance.

Broad Content

Applications of ICT in Rural Development, Networking Concepts, Hardware & Software, LAN Design and Management, Data Sharing, Web Design and Publishing, Website Update and Maintenance, MIS of RD schemes and other e-Governance Services Hands on, Mobile Apps Hands on, Network and Internet security.

Training Methods

The methodology set for the proposed training includes Lecture-cum-Discussion, hands on, live demo. This will be supported by Audio visual aid and PowerPoint presentation. The programme input will be delivered by the faculties of NIRDPR-NERC, Guwahati and also by the invited experts from Technical Institutes other Organisations.
