Free and open-source software (FOSS) is computer software that can be classified as both free software and open-source software. Free refers to 'Freedom to use'. These software are freely licensed to use, copy, modify by any user. The source code is openly shared so that people are encouraged to voluntarily improve the design of the software. This is in contrast to proprietary software software, where the is under restrictive copyright and the source code is usually hidden from the users.

The benefits of using FOSS can include decreasing software costs, increasing security and stability, protecting privacy, and giving users more control over their own hardware. Free, open-source operating systems such as Linux and its family like CentOS, Debian, Ubuntu, Mint used, powering now widely millions of servers, desktops, smartphones (e.g. Android), and other devices. Rural development sector can use and popularize open source software among the functionaries and general masses. The powerful office suites like LibreOffice, OpenOffice, WPS Office can be utilized in place of proprietary software available in the market. In the effort to provide ICT benefits to all and thus delivering e-Governance services to every citizen living in the rural areas of India, free and open-source software can play a pivotal role. Ministry of Communication & Information Technology, Govt. of India as a policy, emphasizes use of open source software in all government departments and e-Governance applications. So this training programme has high relevance in rural development.

Under the above scenario, it is the priority need to understand, learn and implement open source software environment and to enhance skills of functionaries working in rural development and line departments.
