NEED

Life and livelihood are linked to the biological and physical world in a complex way. Human beings are bound by their physical and biological environment in terms of provision of food, water, shelter and other services related to natural environment. Livelihood pattern of tribals is influenced by a number of exogenous factors, which are bringing out changes into the traditional system.

Tribal communities were cultivating and occupying forest land and collect and using forest produce since ages but had no tenurial security. Broadly speaking, the Schedule Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 popularly known as the Forests Rights Act (FRA) recognizes and vests individual forests dwellers with forests rights to live and cultivate in and around the forest land which was occupied before 13th December, 2005 and depend on the forest or forest land for bonafide livelihood needs.

The issues of Tribal Livelihood are complex and they can be tackled by adopting scientific strategy. Land distribution has already been done in most of the states under FRA. But mere distribution of land can't enhance the livelihood of the tribal people. It is essential to frame proper strategy and convergence of other department resources for better utilization of distributed land to tribal people.

Under that background NIRDPR-NERC is proposing to organise 3-days training programme with the following objectives.

OBJECTIVES

1. To enhance the understanding about the premise and salient features of the FRA 2006 and subsequent rules for implementation of Act.
2. To discuss the major challenges for effective implementation of FRA for promotion of Tribal livelihood.
3. To explore the way and methods of post claim mechanism including convergence of different developmental programmes and schemes.
4. To understand the best possible strategies from effective implementation of FRA for improvement of Tribal Livelihoods.

CONTENT

Meaning and concept of livelihood, Tribal livelihood; Forest Rights Act, Premise of the Act of Forest Rights; Challenges of improvement of tribal livelihood under FRA ; Convergence of different developmental programs and schemes; Support system for livelihood – cases and best practices.

TARGET GROUP

State and district level Officials from Tribal Welfare Departments, ADCs, and Officials from other than the part IX areas; Forest department, Tribal Research institutes, Faculties from Tribal Development/Anthropology departments from various universities.
