Need

A computer network is a telecommunications network which allows computers to exchange data. In computer networks, networked computing devices exchange data with each other along network links. The best-known computer network is the Internet. A computer network facilitates interpersonal communications allowing users to communicate efficiently via various means like web portals, email, instant messaging, chat rooms, telephone, video telephone calls, and video conferencing. A network allows sharing of web resources, files, data, and other types of information giving authorized users the ability to access information stored on other computers on the network. Network and Web enabled technologies can enhance performance of the government department to a greater degree and can play a pivotal role in disseminating information and services. One can utilize web applications for online resources management, scheme management, service delivery, e-commerce, education, digital payment, monitoring and evaluation in a fast, effective and transparent means. The process of online data management for RD programmes is being implemented throughout the country. Government is planning to establish massive ICT infrastructure, connectivity backbone and delivery centres across the country under Digital India programme. The vast majority of India's population lives in the villages. Accessing citizen services from rural areas, last mile connectivity along with user-friendly web interfaces are the two most important requirements among others.

In light of the above, it is the utmost priority to upgrade ICT infrastructure, skill enhancement and management procedural re-engineering involving RD/PRI and other line department functionaries. The training programme on "Management of Networking and Web Technologies for of Rural Development Programmes" is proposed mainly for the functionaries of Northeast India serving in the rural development sector. This course will provide the RD/PRI and line department functionaries a platform to learn various tools, technique, applications

and services under a networked environment which shall facilitate better planning and management of various programmes and activities of rural development

Objectives

The main objectives of this training programme are:

- To acquaint with the technical aspects of networking, internet and web applications
- To familiarize and develop idea to work in networked environment
- To identify technicality for establishment of a Local Area Network
- To develop understanding about the process of Web Publishing.
- To learn the techniques of web update, maintenance and security
- To comprehend the various online MIS and other citizen services and Mobile Apps

Programme Content

- Basic System Management
- Computer network: basic concept, types, topology, usefulness, connecting media, Network hardware and software, WiFi, Intranet and Internet.
- Client/ Server, Router and Firewall, IP setup for network management
- Sharing information over Local Area Network
- Design of web pages and web publishing process
- Update and maintenance of web sites and discussion on internet security
- Online transactions, MIS and accessing citizen services
- Concept on Web Server implementation
- Web Conferencing and Video conferencing, IP based surveillance

Lecture-cum-discussions, hands-on, classroom exercise, case studies and live demos.
